Optical Disc de France S.A. leaves suspension of payment and makes restart.

DOCdata N.V. announces that the Trade Court ('Tribunal de Commerce') of Chaumont (France) has decided today to approve the reorganisation plan filed by the management board of Optical Disc de France S.A. in Langres (DOCdata France), a 100% subsidiary of the DOCdata group. As a result, the suspension of payment that was granted to the French company on 1 December 2004 is terminated effective immediately and a restart is being made starting today.

Part of the reorganisation plan is the termination of the labour contracts with approximately 30 employees of DOCdata France and the settlement of debts which has been agreed with the creditors of DOCdata France, of which the majority has chosen to accept a buy-off of the debt against payment by DOCdata France of 25% of the outstanding liability. Furthermore, DOCdata N.V. as ultimate parent company has forgiven the outstanding balance of € 1.9 million for group financing and has provided a new packaging machine to DOCdata France, to enable approval of the reorganisation plan.

DOCdata N.V. announces the 2005 half-year results on Thursday 21 July 2005, before opening of the stock exchange. Till that moment, no announcements will be made regarding the DOCdata results for the first half-year of 2005.
